

HISTORY

The building which was the former Church of Ireland Rectory for Kiltcronaghan dates from the early 19th Century. It is situated beside the Old Church which takes its name from St. Cronagh, who is said to have taught St. Columba his letters. It has now been renovated to provide catering and accommodation for up to 40 people. The building was joined to the Old Church by a tunnel which was blocked up in the 1960s.
